Prescription Needed?	The wide array of parasite control options and where they can be purchased is confusing. The list below is an attempt to help our clients clarify which options we prescribe that may suit your pet(s) best as you shop. Each medication is designated with the locations that it may be purchased, Glenway Animal Hospital (GAH), My Vet Direct (MVD) or Vet Centric (VC).	Glenway Animal Hospital	My Vet Direct

RX	<u>Frontline Plus</u>	GAH	MVD
Yes	(Merial) is a once a month, topically applied flea and tick prevention. Fleas are killed when they ingest Frontline.	YES	NO
RX	<u>Revolution</u>	GAH	MVD
Yes	(Pfizer) is a once a month, topically applied medication, that prevents heartworm, fleas, roundworms, and hookworms . Revolution does not repel or kill ticks. Revolution is commonly used for flea treatment and prevention in rabbits, ferrets, and other small mammals.	YES	NO
RX	<u>Advantage Multi</u>	GAH	MVD
Yes	(Bayer) is a once a month, topically applied medication that prevents heartworm disease, fleas, roundworms and hookworms.	YES	YES
Rx	<u>Capstar</u>	GAH	MVD
YES	(Norvartis) Oral pill administered for severe flea infestation. Kills fleas within 4 to 6 hours of administration. Pill has no residual effects and is used in conjunction with a long acting flea control.	YES	YES
